PLASTIC/GLASS (ie: bottles, packaging etc. - *recycling plastic saves twice as much energy as burning it in an incinerator)

PAPER PRODUCTS (ie: boxes, cardboard, printed material - *27% of newspapers produced are recycled)

WOOD (ie: skids, lumber, crates)

METALS (ie: aluminum cans -* once a can is recycled it can be part of a new can within 6 weeks)

OTHER (ie: styrofoam packaging, batteries, chemicals or fertilizers etc.)

ORGANICS (ie: plant matter, food products, soil, etc.)
